- All Frosted, opal, pearl or other opaque finishes will no longer be able to be supplied unless they are category A energy savers.
- 100W clear GLS.
- 100W, 200W, 300W & 500W linear Halogens.
- 75W clear G9 lamps.
- 15W & 25W clear candle & golf ball lamps if they are class F or G.

1st September 2010



- 75W clear GLS.
- 60W clear G9 lamps.

1st September 2011



- 60W clear GLS.
- 40W clear G9 lamps.

Day 

1st September 2012



- 15W, 25W & 40W clear GLS.
- 25W clear G9 lamps.
- 15W, 25W & 40W clear candle & golf ball lamps.

- S14, S15 & S19 clear capped lamps
