

LED lighting used at media group

Greenled Light has been appointed by London-based Haymarket Media Group to assist in reducing its carbon footprint and increasing energy efficiency through the use of LED lighting. As a result Greenled has installed over 500 LED lamps across Haymarket's four key commercial premises.

Greenled has installed its Antares lamps and has added PIRs in the corridors, lavatories and recreation zones. These additions have reduced energy use in these areas by 90% and is expected to further reduce the company's footprint by 74 carbon tonnes per year. It is also predicted that the new enhancements will save Haymarket Media in excess of £100,000 in electricity costs over the next ten years.

Haymarket's sustainability manager, Nathan McLean said, "Greenled's 5W Antares range use 45W less energy per hour than halogen downlighters and, while there is a marginal reduction in the amount of light emitted, they have proved to be very effective in the areas in which we are using them."

The overhauling of the lighting system at Haymarket is in line with the company's objective to phase out high energy usage halogen bulbs.

The company has implemented a series of environmental initiatives across its buildings as part of a commitment to reducing its impact on the environment.
